#### SCOTTISH HOUSEBUILDERS SHORTLISTED FOR INNOVATION AWARDS

Scottish home building companies have been judged to be 'innovative' by an independent panel and the best have made the shortlist in the Homes for Scotland Innovation Awards which will take place in Glasgow on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2007.

The annual Homes for Scotland quality award scheme is designed to show-case best practice and to encourage the industry to strive for the highest standards. This year's theme of innovation has allowed the industry to demonstrate its success in addressing key issues facing the industry such as the environment, affordability and customer service. The winners will be announced at an event which will be hosted by broadcaster Sally Magnusson and attended by around 700 industry members.

Bruce Black, the Executive Director of Homes for Scotland said: "The quality awards scheme has gone from strength to strength in the five years since it was first lauched. This year the panel are particularly interested in ideas that are genuinely new to the company or to the industry and which, if rolled-out, would have the potential to significantly improve performance, whether that relates to reducing injuries on building sites or homebuilding's carbon footprint".
